



Linguistics Teaching Opportunity March 2014

Teachers wanted for an exciting Linguistics teaching opportunity in Cambridge. Our annual March Linguistics course runs in partnership with a top school in Singapore and is designed for their advanced students studying towards their Linguistics A-level. Our course aims to supplement this A-level curriculum with exposure to undergraduate-level material in an academic environment which is both intellectually challenging and engaging. Topics to be covered include: sociolinguistics, discourse analysis, conversation analysis and dialectology, though we would welcome applicants who specialise in other areas of linguistics.

We are looking for PHD candidates and Post-Doctorates who can communicate their deep knowledge and enthusiasm for linguistics to young people through fun, interactive sessions. Teaching experience is preferred but not essential. Positions of further responsibility are available for suitable candidates – this includes a role as Lead Teacher, co-ordinating the curriculum and the delivery of teaching on the course.

DATES:

We currently have a number of sessions available across our two week course which runs Monday 17th until Friday 28th March, with sessions running weekdays.

HOURS:

Morning sessions run from 9am – 12pm and afternoon sessions run 2pm – 5pm.

WHERE:

Our beautiful 14th century teaching space in Chesterton, on the outskirts of Cambridge City Centre.

PAY:

Teaching rate of £30 per hour with an allowance for planning. For candidates travelling from further afield transport costs can be provided. Positions of further responsibility with greater remuneration are available for suitable candidates.
