The Trustees of the Canadian Centennial Scholarship Fund (CCSF) are pleased to announce the availability of funds for awards (£500-5000) to Canadian men and women for the academic year commencing in **September 2014**. These awards are for academic and artistic studies in the UK, and are exclusively for students who have already commenced their multi-year studies in the UK. Up to 16 awards are given, and include **The Mary LeMessurier** award for the study of history and the **Belle Shenkman** award for the Arts.

DEADLINE

Applications and all relevant material (including references and transcripts) must be received at the above address **no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday March 7th, 2014**. There are no extensions. No applications will be assessed prior to the closing date.

ELIGIBILITY

To qualify for a CCSF award, an applicant must:

1. Be a Canadian citizen.
2. Be currently enrolled full-time in a multi-year postgraduate programme, and at the time of application be attending a UK university or similar institution, **and have completed at least one term of study**.
3. Have very high academic standards.
4. Require funds to complete their studies.

Previous applicants may re-apply.

Interviews will be held in London for candidates who are short-listed. **Students must make themselves available in London for interview to be eligible**. The anticipated interview date is **Thursday May 22nd, 2014**.
